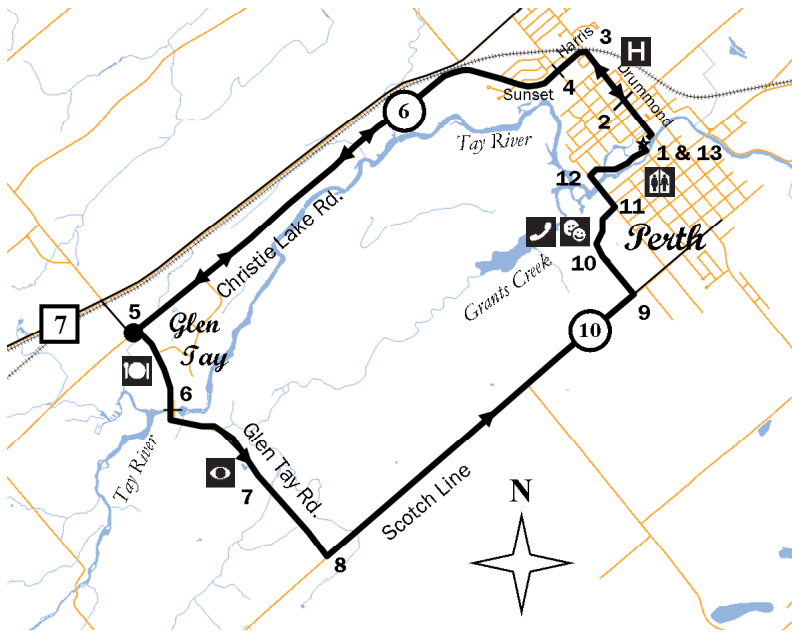


PERTH AREA CYCLING ROUTES

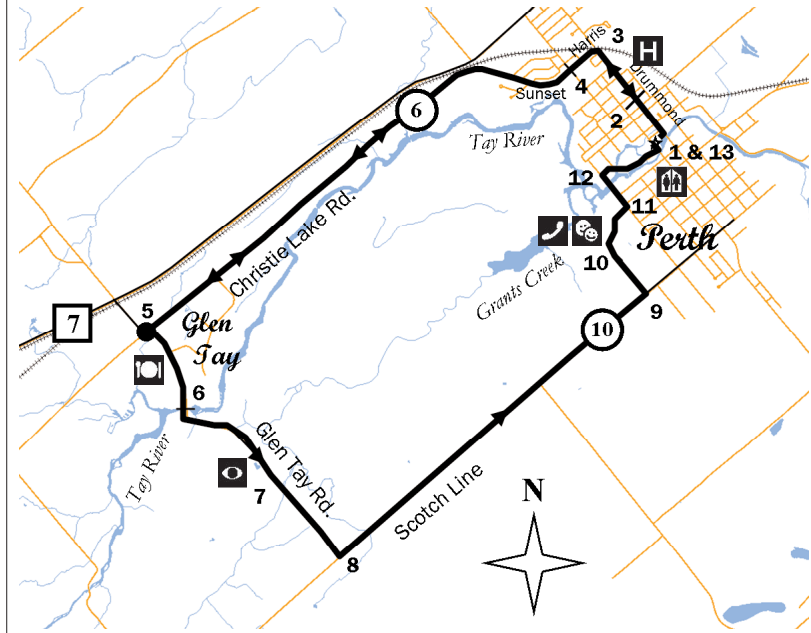
ROUTE 1 · GLEN TAY · 15KM

- 1 Leave the **CRYSTAL PALACE** parking lot and go Northwest on Drummond St.
- 2 You will pass by **PERTH MANOR BOUTIQUE HOTEL**, (built in 1868).
- 3 Turn left onto Harris Street, just before the railway tracks.
- 4 Harris Street becomes Sunset Blvd (County Road #6) at the traffic lights and later becomes Christie Lake Road.
- 5 At the village of **GLEN TAY**, turn left onto the Glen Tay Road. This is also part of the Rideau Heritage Route. Within metres of turning left, you can visit the **LITTLE STREAM BAKERY** for an organic snack. Continue past the bakery and within metres, stop and take a peek at **MCVEIGH'S TAYVIEW MINIATURES AND BARN CRITTERS**.
- 6 Continue up the hill and over. If you enjoy knitting, take a moment to stop on the left side at the bottom of the hill, to visit **janie h. knits**. You are in for a wonderful treat as Janie has some of the most wonderful fabrics!
- 7 Enjoy the tranquil streams and other beautiful scenery along this picturesque roadway.
- 8 Turn left onto Scotch Line Road at the T intersection.

- 9 Turn left on Conlon Road. This road will take you into the fantastic sports fields of Perth, known as **CONLON FARM**. This land was once the Conlon Farmland.
- 10 At the sports fields, go to the right of the chalet, and follow the path past the children's playground and in front of the tennis courts. Please watch for children. This path will take you over a small bridge, which will lead you onto Bathurst Road.
- 11 At the intersection of Bathurst Road and Rogers Road, turn left.
- 12 Cross the Tay River and turn right on the first street (John Street). At the bend, take the small path on your right leading to a beautiful **"RAINBOW BRIDGE"**. Hop off your bike and walk it over this bridge. Travel straight down this street, passing the beautiful **HAGGART HOUSE** on your left and into **STEWART PARK**.
- 13 Cross Gore Street, and you have arrived back at the **CRYSTAL PALACE**.
